73. Hertfordshire Highways

Following discussion, the South West Herts Transportation Strategy Review was noted. Councillor Roe was thanked for studying the document and providing his input and written notes that were distributed to Members present at the meeting.

74. Three Rivers District Council

77. Utilities matters

The consultation on the Draft Water Resources Management Plan (2010 - 2035) for Three Valleys Water was discussed together with a report from Councillor Roe following his attendance at a Three Valleys Water Regional Presentation in Harrow. Councillor Roe was thanked for his contribution and it was agreed that Mrs Morton should draft a response with various points made by Members to be considered by Members at the next meeting.

78. Correspondence

Letter and booklet received from University of Hertfordshire with information regarding the Hertfordshire Planning Charrette - a week of urban design workshops being held from 24th June to 1st July 2008 was noted.

Email from Julie Scott, Three Rivers District Council, advising that residents of Kingsfield Cottages, Tibbs Hill Road, have experienced problems with people finding their properties so want to change the name to Trowley Bottom. Members expressed concern that there would be confusion with a property already named "Trowley Bottom" on Tibbs Hill Road, so were not in favour of renaming but suggested improved, more prominent signage to "Kingsfield Cottages".

Councillor Emery reported he has been advised of significant improvement to Bus route 6 through Bedmond since the meeting attended by "Arriva".

Councillor Miss Young circulated copy of a letter to NATS in response to the airspace consultation that was sent by the Clerk on behalf of the Joint Parish Councils following their meeting on 19th May 2008.
