150. Apologies for absence

Apologies for absence were received, recorded and accepted from Councillors Major and White.

152. Planning decisions from Three Rivers District Council

153. Planning applications as received from Three Rivers District Council

Members discussed the Planning applications list and the comments to be submitted to the District Council are attached at Appendix B.

Mrs Morton advised that the description of planning application 08/1384/ful at 152 Toms Lane had changed from "conversion of timber shed ..." to "Part retrospective: Erection of a timber outbuilding to be used for Agricultural purposes", which is a significant change since the application was discussed at the previous meeting. It was agreed that Mrs Morton email the Planning Officer to clarify the comment because 'no objection' was based on the outbuilding being used for an agricultural purpose, rather than a commercial enterprise (even if handling agricultural produce), and Members would have considered the erection of a timber outbuilding would be inappropriate development in the Green Belt and other issues such as increased traffic would also be a concern.

154. Dacorum Borough Council

An invitation had been received from Dacorum Borough Council to attend a workshop on "The Future Shape of Kings Langley" being held on 19th September. Councillor Morton will attend and Councillor Miss Young said she is interested in attending if she is able to do so and places will be requested for both.
