**262. Apologies for absence**

**266. Three Rivers District Council - Development Control Committee**

**267. Hertfordshire County Council**

The temporary closing of Millhouse Lane, Bedmond, and the temporary closing of various roads in St Albans (near Bedmond), to enable British Telecom maintenance works to take place, notices distributed with the agenda, were noted.

**268. Street Naming and Numbering**

The street name of "Old Trowley" proposed by owners of Kingsfield Cottages was discussed. Members agreed they support the naming of this track/footpath but do not consider Old Trowley is appropriate to this location and continue to prefer the street name to include Kingsfield or Compasses.

The postal address allocated for Hallenhart Kennels, off Harthall Lane was noted.

**269. Correspondence**

A reply received from Hertfordshire Highways clarified that the replacement street lighting columns on High Street Abbots Langley were No. 2 near Tibbs Hill Road junction and No. 11 by the Church and neither are decorative style. The new lanterns will be the latest technology with energy efficient electronic gear and do control light more effectively than older light fittings.
