174. Highway Matters

Mrs Morton had no new highways information to report and advised that the letter to Mr Eaglesham regarding 'ponding' in High Street, Abbots Langley, was delayed due to her absence but has been sent.

Councillor Emery reported that they are still waiting for the Design Team to come back with the scheme for pedestrian refuges on Church Hill.

Councillor Major reported that the requested renewal of road markings at the junction of St Lawrence Close and High Street has been done.

Councillor Major asked about High Street vehicle speed monitoring results and these were briefly summarised (see minute 142). He will request speed checks by the Police in the vicinity of St Lawrence Church. Councillor Miss Young suggested vehicle speed monitoring in Langley Lane be requested between South Way and College Road and this was agreed.

Mrs Morton reported that the issue of Parish Councils not being allowed to comment on relevant TRDC Licensing applications is ongoing; it was raised at the Joint Clerks meeting and HAPTC are asking Parish Councils for information on what representation other District Councils allow on Licensing in their areas.
