528. Planning applications as received from Three Rivers District Council

Members discussed the Planning applications list and **RESOLVED** the comments to be submitted to the District Council as attached at Appendix B.

529. London Borough of Hillingdon

The outline planning application relating to RAF Uxbridge Hillingdon Road, Uxbridge was noted.

530. Highways Agency

The M25 Widening Exhibition to be held in Henderson Hall on 12th and 13th March 2010 being organised by Skanska Balfour Beatty was noted.

531. Three Rivers District Council

The consultations on

- a. The Three Rivers District Council (Gallows Hill Lane Slip Road, Abbots Langley)(Waiting Restrictions) Order 2010 was noted.
- b. The Three Rivers District Council (Abbots Road, Little How Croft, Gallows Hill and Kindersley Way, Abbots Langley)(Waiting Restrictions) Order 2010 was noted.
- c. The Three Rivers District Council (Kindersley Way and Abbots Road, Abbots Langley)(Waiting Restrictions) Order 2010 was noted.

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Members understand the reasons for the proposed orders and they are also concerned that parking on the central grass area between the slip road and Gallows Hill Lane is causing damage and making this amenity green space look unattractive so it was agreed to suggest measures to prevent this happening may need to be taken.

532. Hertfordshire County Council

The Temporary Closing of various roads in Kings Langley to enable highway maintenance works to take place. Sections of Station Road and Primrose Hill will each be closed for up to five days, sometime between 15th February and 31st March 2010 and Railway Terrace will be closed for up to thirty days sometime between 29th March and 30th April 2010, when signs are in place. It was drawn to the Committee's attention by Julie Barton, The Villager, that Kings Langley Parish Council are concerned that these closures could take place at the same time as road works through Kings Langley village. It was agreed to write to HCC to ask for assurance that works are being co-ordinate so both routes are not obstructed at the same time.

533. Highway matters

High Street, Abbots Langley - position of car park signage at entrances to village is to be agreed with Soyna Packett to be proposed to Herts Highways.

C76 - the Temporary Closure of Station Road, Primrose Hill and Railway Terrace will be related to the planned improvement works.

C77 - Councillor Emery reported that the current phase of works appear to be almost complete. However, a pedestrian refuge is still wanted near Newlands.
