### 1. Apologies

## 2. See attached Report Twelve to the Parish Council dated 26th February 2018.

As the Chair has been abroad on holiday for 5 weeks in February/March 2018 and then another family holiday for one week after Easter, little progress has been made on the Neighbourhood Plan since the end of February. The February Progress Report outlines the work plan going forward in 2018.

3. Housing Policies. - Report back on seminar on "Community Led Housing."

Attended by Cllr Brenda Kersey and Jon Tankard on 20<sup>th</sup> February 2018. Seminar on 'Community-Led Housing' organised by CDA Herts 'to help local parish councils to unlock the barriers to providing affordable housing for current and future generations.'

4. Housing Policies. – Press Announcement that five Local Districts are cooperating on Housing Development Requirements in their Local Plans to meet Government Targets.

This announcement is a major change for local housing policies. It is unclear whether this will result in no demand for development of housing on Green Belt land within the Parish of Abbots Langley. Until further information on this District Planning policy is explained, the Housing Policy for the Parish should remain as explained in Parish Council's response to the Three Rivers District Local Plan – in September 2017.

#### 5. Neighbourhood Plan Web Site

Using the Web design structure provided by John Austin, the proposed web site will be incorporated into the Parish Web site within the Section on 'Planning.' This work will be commissioned using the services of the Web Developer used by the Parish Council.

### 6. On-going Work Programme for 2018

#### 7. Ongoing Work from our Consultants to use the Government Grant.

John Austin's work was completed on **13**<sup>th</sup> **December**. Alison Eardley was commissioned on 8<sup>th</sup> December 2017 to do further work. Alison's 30-page report 'Abbots Langley Neighbourhood Plan – Parish Profile' is attached and circulated with this agenda.

8. Meeting with other NP Groups in our area Kings Langley, Croxley Green, Chorleywood, and St Stephens (Bricket Wood)

We are aware that Neighbourhood Plans are being developed in some of our Neighbouring Parishes. Alison, our Consultant, is advising St Stephens and has been recently appointed by

Kings Langley. The Chair has been approached by three of the above four Parishes to meet with them to share information and experience in a spirit of cooperation. No action yet on this meeting.
