ALPC meeting 01/02/2023

Riverside Old Mill Road Hunton Bridge WD4 8QT - Retrospective: Construction of a bridge across the stream.

ALPC Comment: Members note the ecological report regarding the presence of a bridge previously at this site, however, given this is in the greenbelt members question if there are any very special circumstances which would warrant approval for a new structure to be built.

TRDC Decision: refused

Reason: Permission is refused for the following reason(s):-

1 The outbuilding is inappropriate development, by definition and also results in actual harm to the openness of the Green Belt. The outbuilding also by virtue of its scale, siting and layout is not considered to fall within the scope of Policy DM2 of Development Management Policies LDD (adopted July 2013). It is considered that very special circumstances do not exist to outweigh the harm of the development to the Green Belt by virtue of its inappropriateness, actual harm to the openness of the Green belt and any other harm identified. As such the outbuilding is contrary to Policy CP11 of the Core Strategy (adopted October 2011), Policy DM2 of the Development Management Policies LDD (adopted July 2013) and the NPPF (2021).

2 In the absence of sufficient information, it has not been demonstrated that the outbuilding built across the watercourse has not had an adverse impact on flooding and the adjacent Grand Union Canal watercourse. Therefore necessary consideration and appropriate mitigation cannot be given to the impact of the outbuilding contrary to Policy CP1 of the Core Strategy (adopted October 2011), Policy DM8 of the Development Management Policies LDD (adopted July 2013) and the NPPF (2021).

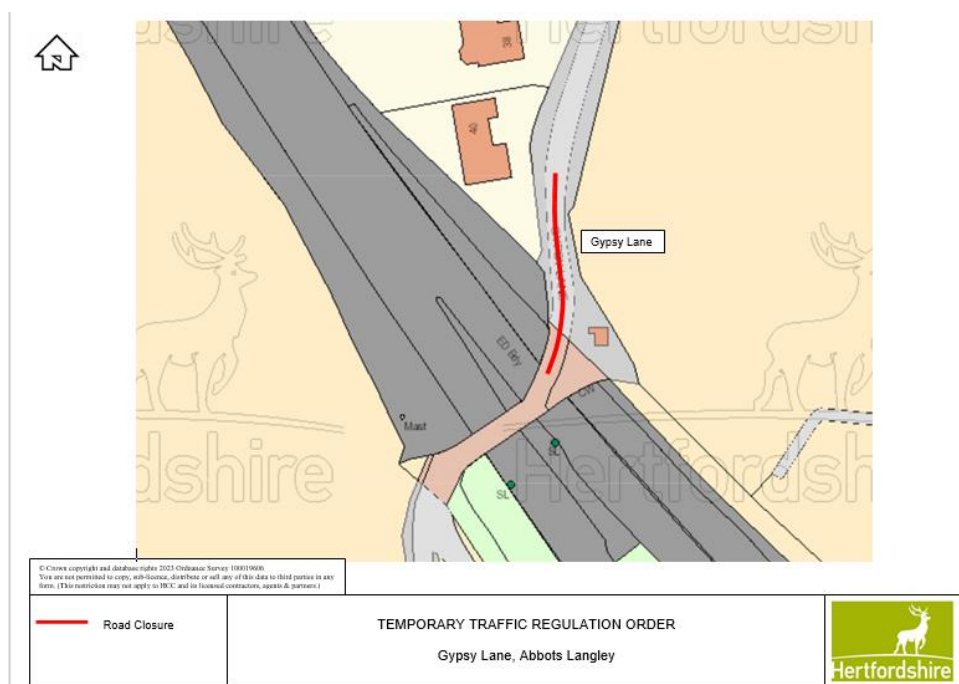


Appendix C1

Road closures and restrictions within the parish:

1. TRO21580 - The Hertfordshire (Temporary Closing of Gypsy Lane, Abbots Langley)

NOTICE is given that the Hertfordshire County Council intends to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, to prohibit all vehicular traffic from using that length of Gypsy Lane, Abbots Langley from a point 40m north east of its junction with Abbots Langley Bridleway and Public Footpath No.040 north eastwards for a distance of approximately 45m ("the Road"). There is no alternative route available for vehicles when the works are being carried out. However vehicular access to properties in this road will be maintained whenever possible throughout the duration of the works. The Order is needed because utility service works are proposed to be executed on or near the Road. If the Order is made, it shall come into force on 28 March 2023 for a period of up to 18 months. However, the restrictions specified shall only take effect at the times indicated by signs on or near the Road.

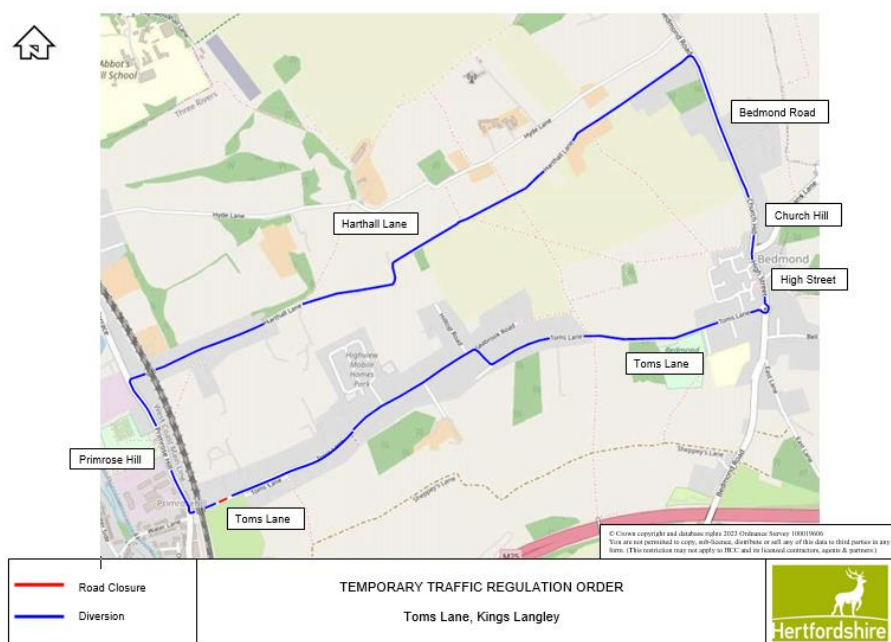


2. TRO21727 - The Hertfordshire (Temporary Closing of Toms Lane, Kings Langley)

NOTICE is given that the Hertfordshire County Council intends to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, to prohibit all vehicular traffic from using that length of Toms Lane, Kings Langley from a point in line with the eastern boundary of No.7 Toms Lane south westwards to a point in line with the western boundary of No.3A Toms Lane, a distance of approximately 48m ("the Road"), except for access. An alternative route will be via Toms Lane, High Street, Church Hill, Bedmond Road, Harthall Lane, Primrose Hill and Toms Lane. The Order is needed because utility service works are proposed to be executed on or near the Road. If the Order is made, it shall come into force on 17 April 2023 for a period of up to 18 months. However, the restrictions specified shall only take effect at the times indicated by signs on or near the Road.

3. TRO21730 - The Hertfordshire (Temporary Closing of Lauderdale Road, Hunton Bridge during a 'King's Coronation Street Party')

NOTICE is given that Hertfordshire County Council intends to make an Order under Section 16(A) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, to prohibit all vehicular traffic from using that length of Lauderdale Road, Hunton Bridge from its junction with Hunton Bridge Hill north westwards to its junction with Hamilton Road, a distance of approximately 300 metres, except for access. An alternative route will be via Hunton Bridge Hill and Hamilton Road. The section of road will be closed between the hours of 11.00am and 9.00pm on Sunday 7 May 2023, when signs are in place. The purpose of the Order is to ensure public safety and prevent accidents for the duration of the 'King's Coronation Street Party'.
